Kaotic Concrete - Time to Build - 12"/CD Single

After creating a buzz through the releases of his group, the UnderClassMen, Kaotic drops his first solo effort while finishing the upcoming UnderClassMen album.



Time to Build delivers a variety of beats and styles. The vinyl features the tracks "Time to Build" and "Knock on Wood" produced by long time swiss beat veteran Vasi and "Competitor/Predator" featuring Trig produced by UnderClassMen's own beat wizzard Phil "Pro" Hoffa plus all the Instrumentals. The CD features all the tracks and instrumentals from the Vinyl plus the additional track and instrumental Black Ink produced by Phil "Pro" Hoffa. Videoclip to Competitor/Predator will rotate on various TV-Stations soon.

Biography

Kaotic grew up in Boston, Mass. till he was 16 years old when he moved to Basel/Switzerland to pursue a career in broadcasting. He was strongly influenced by Hip-Hop in Boston so when he arrived in Basel he soon connected with the growing local scene in the early 90's. Already in 1995 he was featured on an European Rap Compilation. The important date remains 1998 when Kaotic, Trig, Phil "Pro" Hoffa and DJ A.L.K. formed the UnderClassMen. Hard work and dedication since then has led to numerous european releases and eventually to their first international 12" Single "Weak Ideas" which quickly became a classic

in Switzerland and also generated attention from Germany and the U.S. This led to the collaboration with DJ Next to be featured on his "Back to the Grill, again" CD, where the UnderClassMen dropped "My Hip-Hop" together with Promoe (Looptroop). In 2002 Landspeed Records picked up the UnderClassMens second 12" "365 Live" which quickly sold out. In 2004 the UnderClassMen teamed up with K-Otix and Dante (Mood) to record the Phil Pro produced track "Make Way" which is featured on the "Ethos" Album, distributed worldwide by GrooveAttack. Now Kaotic's here to further pave the way with "Time to Build" to ensure heads are ready for the UnderClassMen album coming in 2005!

The UnderClassMen have also gained a reputation for being live on stage after supporting various U.S. acts as they tour Europe such as K-Otix, Lone Catalysts, Bumpy Knuckles, Grand Agent, Jeru the Damaja, Defari, Supernatural, The Beatjunksies, I.G. OFF, Gauge, Lords of the Underground and German Groups like Blumentopf, Eimsbush and MC Rene.
